Workshop Costs

1. NLA Instructional Fee: \$350 for 3 weeks
 2. Housing: \$35 per night x 19 nights = \$665
 3. Meals: \$24 a day x 15 days = \$360

Housing

Students will share rooms with other participants. The dorm rooms have 2 beds with a bathroom and a small microwave and fridge. Sheets, pillow, blanket and towels will be available but it's always safe to bring your own. Twin size beds are a little longer so regular twin size sheets are small.
