### 2010 Summer Courses

The University of New Mexico provides credit for courses. **Students are responsible for taking care of registration and fees for UNM.** For the summer you are allowed to take 9 credit hours. **NLA staff will be available at the beginning of the workshop to answer questions about receiving credit for courses and to help with the registration paperwork.**

Our courses are intensive, condensed into a four-week period. Therefore, we do not recommend that students enroll in more than two courses each for credit.

We recommend that participants attend the workshop for the entire four weeks.

In addition to the regularly scheduled classes, there will be other activities from time to time (if time permits) such as guest lectures, group discussions, and field trips. Lectures and discussions will focus on topics relevant to language teaching and linguistic theory. Guest lecturer may include institute participants, researchers from the University, and others specializing in the Navajo language and/or education.

### Limited Space

Because classroom space is limited, we can only accept a limited number of students. Applicants will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Therefore, early registration is encouraged.



### Workshop Costs

- Tuition and Materials: \$350 for 4 weeks
- Housing/Dorm Room: \$40/night (\$1,000-25 nights)
- Meals: \$15 to \$25 a day

Total cost (not including meals): \$1,350 (based on 25 days)

\*Please note: the cost of housing goes to the University of New Mexico; the cost of meals will be at your own expense. Also, note that we have increased NLA fees.

### Housing

Students will share rooms with other participants. The apartment-style rooms have 4 beds and also have kitchen facilities. Check in time is July 5, 2008 after 1:00 pm.

**Bedding and towels are available from UNM at a cost to you of \$3.00 per week unless you bring your own. Also bring dishes, pots and pans if you want to do your own cooking.**

Please specify on registration form if you prefer particular roommates. Everyone will have a roommate.

### Meals

There are kitchens in the dormitories. The Student Union has various eating places. If you choose to eat there then meal tickets are available for purchase. Inquire when you come in the first day.

### Parking

Parking is \$28 per week (\$112 for 4 weeks). **This must be paid at check-in time.**

### Financial Assistance

We offer financial assistance to those who need it and are not on salary during the workshop. This assistance can include help with the cost of housing and a tuition waiver. Please indicate on the registration form if you need help.
